

Things that we did the week of May 2

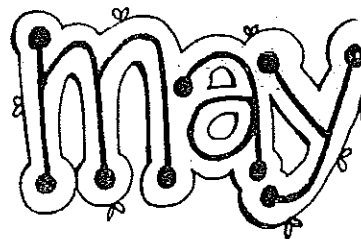

The trick about this type of planting is that we have to plant a capital letter flower next to its lowercase matching flower. We all agree planting is so much fun!

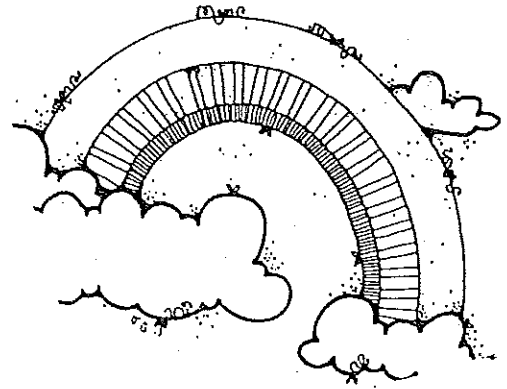

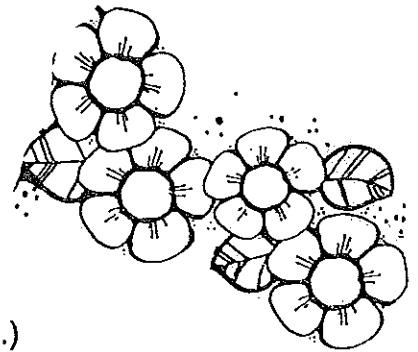
