

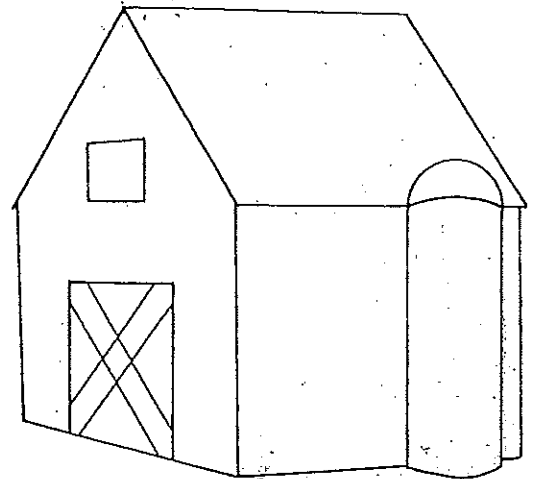


Things that we did the week of May 9

- **Butterflies, Rhyming, and Letter/Number** reviewing will be on our minds the next few weeks as the school year winds down.

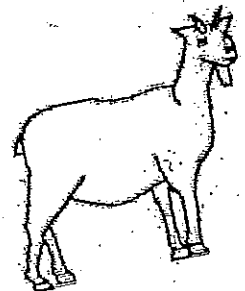
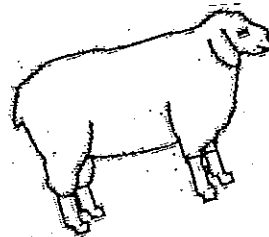
