

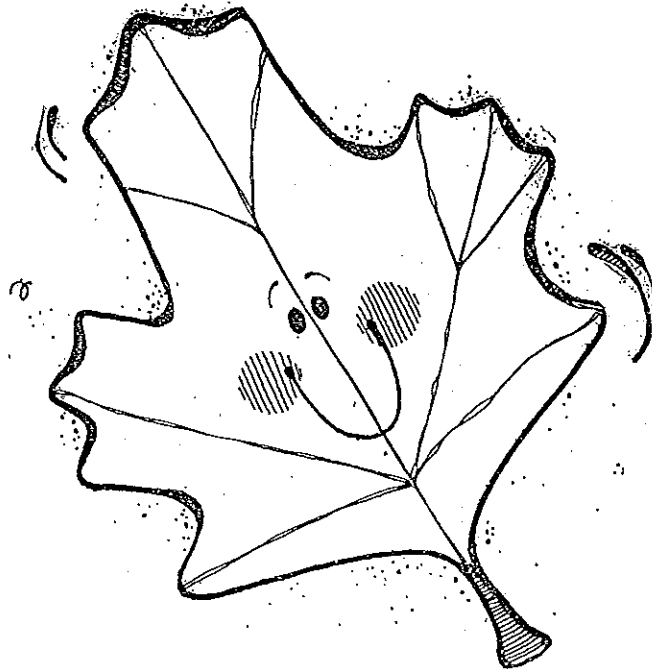
# September

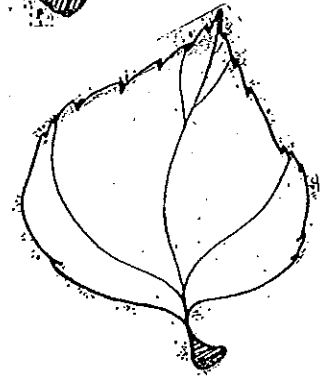
