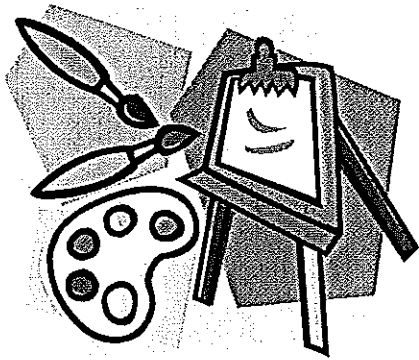

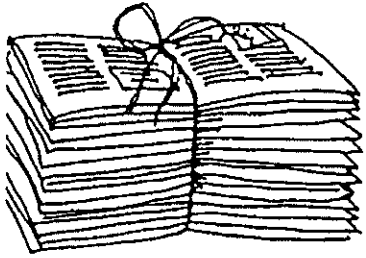
AFTER SCHOOL ART CLUB!!!

Art Club is sponsored by funding from the Safe Schools/Healthy Students Dodge County Consortium.



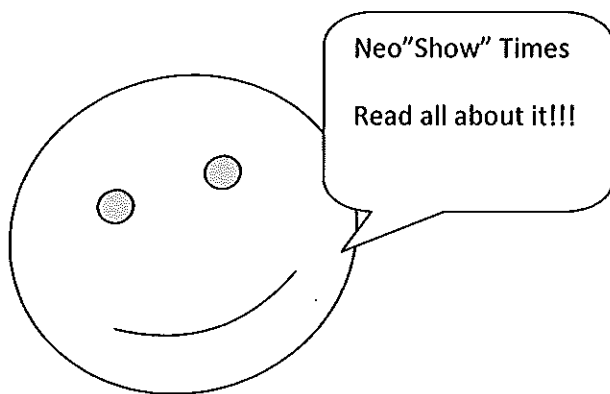
Neo"Show" Times

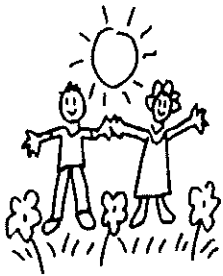
