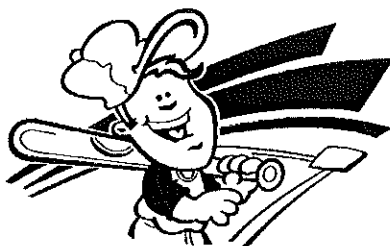

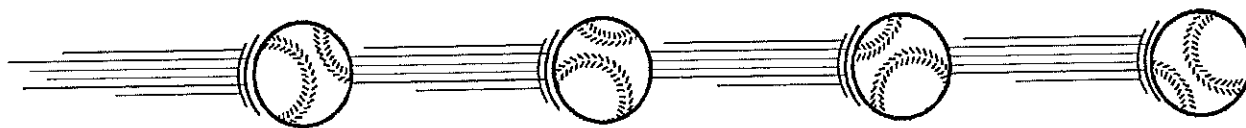
Neosho Rockets Youth Baseball League

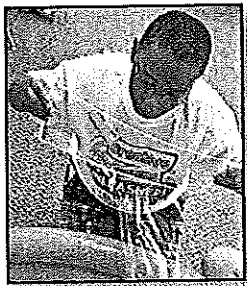
