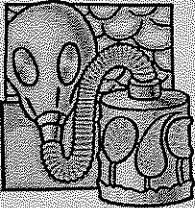


# RED RIBBON WEEK

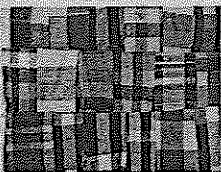
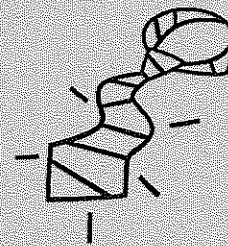


Monday 10/18: Wear green clothing items

The theme is: "Don't let drugs twist your mind."

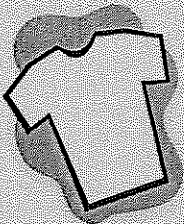


Wednesday 10/20: Wear colorful or mismatched clothes.

Friday 10/22: Wear red or school spirit clothing.

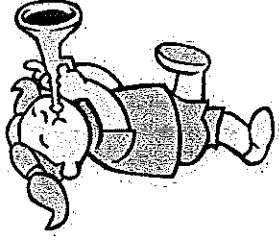
The theme is "Wear red day - Pledge to be drug free."

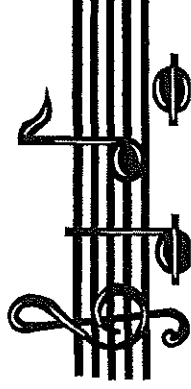

**Who:** Mr. Pohland will be there to help

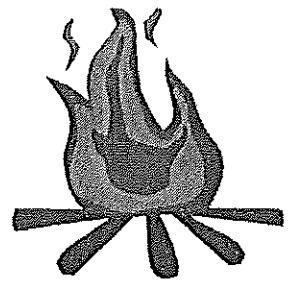

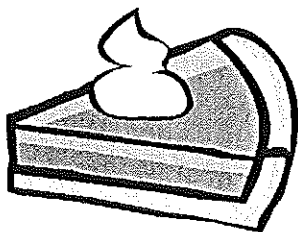


# COMMUNITY BONFIRE
