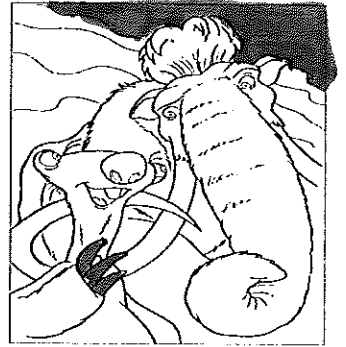

INFORMATIONAL RELEASE

SUSPICIOUS SUBJECT

On Thursday, December 15, 2011, at approximately 4:15pm, an eight-year-old juvenile was in the area of a playground at the Rossman Elementary School, located at 600 Highland Ave., when they observed a male subject standing near the school's fence line, immediately to the east of the school property, in the Hartford Senior Friends Center's parking lot.

The juvenile reports that the subject shouted, attempting to coerce them into entering his vehicle. The juvenile ran home and reported the matter to their parents, and the Hartford Police Department was subsequently contacted. The subject in this incident did not approach the juvenile, nor did he make any attempts to physically force the juvenile to accompany them.

The male subject is described as a white male, approximately 35 years of age, roughly 5' 10" with a medium build, with very short dark brown hair, and a "stubby" mustache and goatee. The subject was last seen wearing a dark brown hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans. The subject was reported to have a red, mid-sized car, of an unknown make and model.

At this point in the investigation, there is no evidence to suggest that this incident is directly related to any previous incidents in the Hartford area.

The Hartford Police Department has shared this information with area law enforcement agencies and the Hartford area schools to make them aware of these allegations.

Anyone with information regarding this incident is encouraged to call the Hartford Police Department at (262)673-2600, or to report the information anonymously via the Washington County Law Enforcement Tip Line at (800)232-0594. The caller can remain anonymous, and information leading to arrests can result in a reward for the tipster.

Our investigation into this incident is ongoing, and no further information is being released at this time.
