New Technology @Neosho School

In an effort to reach and engage students as they best like to learn and prepare them for the 21st century classroom, Neosho School is moving ahead with a "technology forward" initiative.

An iPad cart was purchased in January that currently houses twenty (20) iPads for teacher check out and student use. In 2011, interactive projectors were installed in almost every classroom in order to bring the world of Web 2.0 to Neosho School. In addition, our Library Media Center (LMC) is in the process of updating it's existing computers and will be adding six new computers in the near future. The LMC will soon be a second computer lab for all of Neosho School to access throughout the school day.

Students that bring their personal technology devices are able to access our wireless network and must abide by our Acceptable Use Policy. Please note that failure to follow the district AUP may result in the loss of a student's ability to use personal and/or school district provided technology. Students are encouraged to bring in ear buds for their personal use when working with computers/iPads.

Professional development in the technology arena will continue to be a major focus for the faculty as we increase the use of computer based curriculum resources, instructional tools, and 21st century assessment formats. It's an exciting time to be teaching and learning at Neosho School!

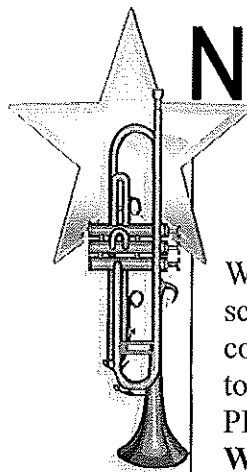
