Spring Measurement of Academic Progress Assessments

Neosho School students, Grades 2-8, will be completing a second round of Measures of Academic Progress™ (MAP) assessments this May. The formative assessments will be used to determine your child's instructional level, to measure academic growth throughout the school year and to measure progress from year to year in the areas of Reading, Math, and Language. Students will complete the tests on a computer.

During the spring testing period, your child will spend a total of about three hours completing formative assessments throughout May3-5 & May10-12. MAP tests are unique in that they adapt to be appropriate for your child's level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed and maintain a positive attitude toward testing.

Our students did an excellent job during the winter assessments! The faculty at Neosho School was truly impressed with their commitment and focus. We are excited to share with you the reports that will focus on your child's individual growth and achievement. Thank you for your partnership throughout the 2010-2011 school year.

Following this spring's testing period, you will receive a parent friendly report showing your child's growth. Please contact your child's classroom teacher with any questions or concerns related to the MAP report sent home in May.

And one other reminder 3D glasses are available for purchase for one dollar in advance, a limited number of glasses will be available for purchase the day of the concert.

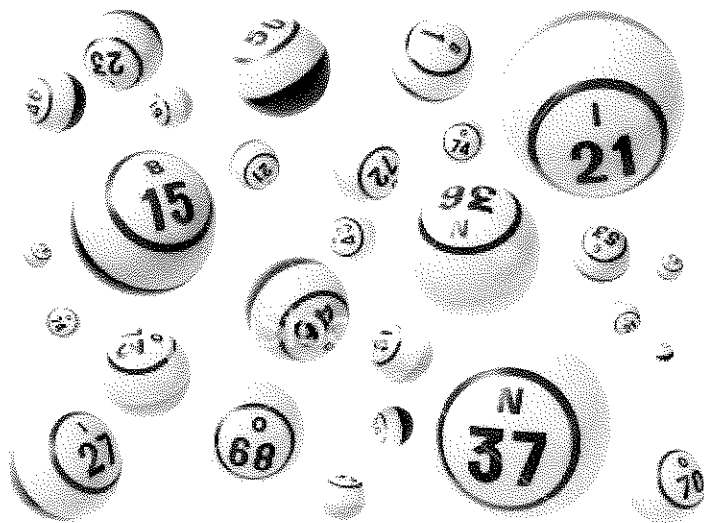
