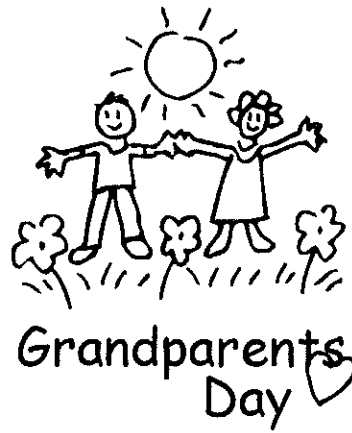

**Welcome back to Warrior Nation Football.** Last year was a special season for everyone involved. We should all be proud of the effort put forth by everyone. With that said it is now time for a reality check. The only thing tougher than becoming champion .....is staying champion.

I have stated in the past that **School Comes First**, and I still stand by that. I expect our players to put forth the extra effort to not only play football, but to put their best effort in at school. I expect our players to behave **better** in class. Our players must understand that sports are a privilege.

Last year we had a great turnout from parents at the games, that means a lot to have your support. While our team is smaller in numbers, it is not smaller in desire. I see those practice squad kids have come to play and they are ready. We will again have a practice squad of 5<sup>th</sup> graders that will practice with the team and build the skills necessary to play as 6<sup>th</sup> graders.

This season will present new challenges for us as a team and as individuals. I believe that learning to rise to these challenges will be a lesson worth learning.
